The letter forms used in lowercase italic fonts do not always match those used in the regular font, but in SmallCaps they ought to. In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use '...' or "... " but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

LEFT AND RIGHT DOUBLE QUOTES “...”	AND LEFT DOUBLE QUOTES „...“
