The English text here is in Noto Sans. In Mongolia, the language is usually written with a cyrillic alphabet, but the Mongolian script (which is written vertically and from left to right) is still used for decorative purposes. According to wikipedia, the script is still used in Inner Mongolia (China), but I think it is unlikely that there will ever be any text in this script on the web, except in images. As before, this is article 1 of the UDHR.
