

IPAexMincho (ipaexm.ttf v004.01)

This Japanese serif font covers Japanese and some European languages using Latin alphabets (unlike the older IPAMincho it has proportional spacing for the Latin letters). Although it does have the OpenType tags for Cyrillic, Greek and CJK scripts, the Cyrillic letters are too widely spaced while the monotonous Greek lack dialytika and tonos and the lowercase tend towards oblique - both the Cyrillic and Greek texts would overflow the margin and are not shown here.

Similarly, for French Harfbuzz has added a combining diaeresis after the capital Y - an uncommon capital letter, I have accepted fonts where that letter lacks the diaeresis so will accept it here. For Latvian (cedillas) and Welsh (accents on w,y) this font is unsuitable.

For variations of the Latin alphabets I attempt to show the whole alphabet, followed by Article 1 of the UDHR (it is traditional!). For other scripts and languages I merely display the digits (if not common 0..9) and Article 1.

It has in excess of 10,000 Kanji so should cover all common Japanese text.

The Japanese punctuation omits white square brackets which do not seem to be common.

3 Quotation-marks, etc.

In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use '...' or "...'" but in good text there are variations and this font supports:

left and right single quotes ‘...’	angle brackets <...>
left and right double quotes “...”	double angle brackets «...»
single turned comma, with right single quote ‘...’	corner brackets 「...」
guillemets «...»	white corner brackets 『...』
angle quotes <...>	

In Spanish languages, the inverted exclamation-mark ¡ and inverted question-mark ¿ are necessary.
