## 2 QUOTATION-MARKS, ETC.

*In real-world usage, particularly when looking at news sites, the presence or absence of the correct quote characters will make a difference. As a coder, I use ‘...’ or “...” but in good text there are variations and this font supports:*

LEFT AND RIGHT SINGLE QUOTES ‘...’	DOUBLE LOW 9,
LEFT AND RIGHT DOUBLE QUOTES “...”	AND LEFT DOUBLE QUOTES „...“
SINGLE TURNED COMMA,	GUILLEMETS «...»
WITH RIGHT SINGLE QUOTE ‘...’	ANGLE QUOTES <...>

IN SPANISH LANGUAGES, THE INVERTED EXCLAMATION-MARK ¡ AND INVERTED QUESTION-MARK ¿ ARE NECESSARY.

IN IRISH, IN REAL LIFE THE WORD ‘AGUS’ (AND) IS OFTEN SHORTENED TO ‘ḡ’ WHICH IS A SYMBOL FOR THE LATIN ‘ET’ AND IT MAY VERY OCCASIONALLY BE SEEN ON THE WEB.
